

Next Step

- 1. Pay Acceptance Fee – Congratulations! You have been offered provisional admission Into Godfrey Okoye University.** The next step is to pay the acceptance fee of N30,000.
How to pay acceptance fee: login to <https://erp.gouni.edu.ng/Security/Accounts/Login>
Username: your email address
Password: your application number- gou/20/000.....
 - On login click on pay acceptance fee
 - To pay online with ATM Card –click on **PAY VIA REMITA USING CARD.**
 - To pay at any bank branch – copy out **the 12 digits RRR NUMBER** and take it to any commercial bank branch and pay using **REMITA PLATFORM**
- 2. Sign and send acceptance form**– on successful payment, click on print acceptance fee or print doc, download, sign and send to info@gouni.edu.ng
- 3. Pay tuition fees and other payments**– follow the process above to pay tuition and other fees. You can also pay at the Microfinance Bank on Campus. **If you are applying to read LAW, you can pay your tuition fee after a successful interview.** View tuition fee and other payments - <https://www.gouni.edu.ng/payments/>
- 4.** If Godfrey Okoye is not your first choice university, go to the JAMB office or any good cyber and do change of institution, choosing Godfrey Okoye University as your first choice. Make sure you have uploaded your O’Level Result to JAMB. Return to the campus with (1) the original printout of your JAMB result, printed from the JAMB portal; (2) Evidence of Upload of O’Level result to Jamb; (3) Printout of Acknowledgment Slip from Godfrey Okoye University Admission Portal.
- 5. Book accommodation online**–after payment on your student Dashboard, click on hostel accommodation, follow the instruction and select a room. Print out the accommodation slip, present it to the hostel moderator on checking in.

-FAQ-

Can I pay in two installments? Yes, you can pay 50% first semester (October), the remaining 50% in second semester (February). Any other adjustment should be discussed with the university Bursar.

How can I make payments? You can pay online with your ATM card or **generate Remita RRR invoice** and pay at any of the university's bank branch in Nigeria. The University Service banks are:

How do I generate RRR? Login to your student

Dashboard: <https://erp.gouni.edu.ng/Security/Accounts/Login>

Click on payments, Generate payment invoice, a page will display, select payment type from the drop down menu, click on **Generate Invoice**.

Copy out the 12 digits **RRR REMITA NUMBER** take it to any commercial bank in Nigeria, pay using **REMITA platform**. You can also pay online with your ATM CARD by clicking on **PAY VIA REMITA USING CARD**.

Do I need university account number to make payments through Remita? NO, the 12 digits **RRR REMITA NUMBER** generated serves as the account number.

What do I need for study and for the hostel? Personal Laptop, Cell phone, box with lock, one-man plastic table and chair, cupboard with locks, buckets, water cans, 2 bed sheets and pillow and pillow slips, mosquito net, cooking utensils and kero stove (if you want), mop, hangers and pegs. The university will provide mattress. If you are not resident in Enugu, some of these items could be bought from markets close to the campus.

Does the university feed students? NO, students are allowed to cook or buy food at the restaurants around.

Can I stay off campus? NO, Except on health conditions or if you are taking care of an elderly or sick relative. You will however apply to the Vice Chancellor for off-campus permit.

When can I resume for the new academic session? Compulsorily 7th October 2021. Please arrive at the university before 2:00PM so that you can finish your admission process before end of work by 4:00PM.

How do I locate the university? Thinker's Corner Campus - **Landmark:** 82 Divisional Headquarters (Military Barracks) Enugu Abakaliki Express, Behind National Orthopedic Hospital Enugu, Enugu State, Nigeria.

Can I book for a taxi pick up? Yes. Download OMA TAXI APP from PLAYSTORE or APPLE STORE. When you reach Enugu, request for a taxi pick up using OMA app. OR pick a local KeKe bus to bring you to the university main gate.

Is there a BANK ATM Machines around? Yes. The university has GTbank and UBA ATM machines within the campus. Other bank ATM can be located nearby.

What must I do on reaching the campus? You must report at the Admissions Unit at the Office of the Registrar, between 9am and 4pm, to fill hardcopies of the admission and acceptance forms and get a clearance to enter the hostel.

What documents do I need to present on resumption?

- Jamb change of institution print out (if Godfrey Okoye University was not your first choice)
- Evidence of upload of OLevel result to JAMB
- Print out of original Jamb result
- Acknowledgment Slip; Admission letter; Acceptance form
- Evidence of all payments
- O Level results (NCE, OND where applicable)
